The Delegate Minister to the Presidency in charge of Defence visits the Nachtigal sites

Getting a close-up view of the Nachtigal's site installations

On the 23rd of August 2023, the Minister Delegate at the Presidency in charge of Defence (MINDEF) undertook a working visit to the Nachtigal sites, namely the business estate and the Nachtigal construction site. The visit was part of the retrocession process of the business estate to MINDEF on completion of the construction works.

Led by NHPC's Deputy Managing Director, the visit was attended by representatives of the Ministries of Water and Energy, Land Registry and Land Affairs, all members of the working group on the business estate's retrocession to MINDEF, as well as the administrative and local authorities of the project area.

During a guided tour led by NHPC with specific stops, the Minister was able to get a close-up view of the business estate's installations and visit the Nachtigal construction site, which was 88.4% complete at the end of July 2023. At the end of the visit, he expressed his satisfaction with the quality and maintenance of the business estate's installations and the progress of the construction works.

As a reminder, MINDEF has been providing security for all of the the Nachtigal hydroelectric facility's infrastructures since 28 July 2018 under a partnership agreement signed with NHPC.

About the Nachtigal business estate

Covering 94 ha, the Nachtigal business estate includes offices, hotels and accommodation, a fire station, kitchens and restaurants, a medical centre with a laboratory, pharmacy and bedrooms, sports facilities, etc.

In addition to this business estate, MINDEF is responsible for securing all areas of the Nachtigal hydroelectric facility, the Nachtigal-Nyom 2X225 KV transmission line and the Nachtigal housing estate.
