



NHPC improves access to potable water in the project area

21 boreholes and 3 water towers for the project area district

From December 5 to 7, 2023, NHPC has carried out a retrocession tour of drinking water access points built by the company for the benefit of the populations of Batchenga, Obala, Ntui. This handover, which took place in the presence of the local administrative and traditional authorities, includes:

- For Batchenga: 6 boreholes equipped with a human-powered pump in Ballong 1, Ballong 2, Ndji, Olembé, and Emana Batchenga and 1 water tower for Batchenga District Medical Center.
- For Ntui: 2 boreholes equipped with a human-powered pump in Obamdéné and Bidanjengué and 1 water tower to supply Ntui District Hospital.
- For Obala: 13 boreholes equipped with a human-powered pump in Elomzok, Minkama village, Mekas, Nkolobili, Nkolguem2, Nkolbene, Nkolguem 1, Nto, Nkometou 3, Nkometou 2, Mfomakap, Mindjomo, Mbele, et 1 solar water tower in Nkomndamba.
