Nachtigal's Unit No. 1 officially commissioned

On the 14th of June 2024, the Nachtigal hydroelectric facility Unit No. 1's Demonstrative Global Capacity Certificate was officially signed by the Managing Directors of NHPC, SONATREL and ENEO, main actors in Cameroon's electricity sector. The ceremony was held in the presence of the Water and Energy Minister (MINEE), NHPC's lenders and technical and financial partners.

The signing of this certificate marks the official commissioning of Nachtigal's Unit No. 1 (60 MW), as announced, one month after it was synchronized and connected to the Southern Interconnected Grid, enabling the injection of its first megawatt-hours into the grid.

Nachtigal, construction works making good progress

The signing of the Nachtigal hydroelectric facility Unit No. 1's Demonstrative Global Capacity Certificate represents a significant step forward for the Nachtigal project, which was 94.5% completed at the end of May.

NHPC remains committed to deliver the entire Nachtigal hydroelectric facility by December 2024. Works continue to this end, to ensure the gradual commissioning of the facility's remaining 6 units over the coming months.

Once commissioned, Nachtigal will supply 420 MW, covering 30% of Cameroon's energy needs. The energy produced by Nachtigal will be transported by SONATREL and distributed by ENEO.
