## Immersion in the Nachtigal project

The Grand Inga Project Development and Promotion Agency (ADPI-RDC), on a tour in Cameroon, visited the Nachtigal hydroelectric facility on the 19<sup>th</sup> of June 2024.

The visit, led by NHPC's Operations Director, included two stops, at the main dam and at the Nachtigal plant.

For the ADPI-RDC, the visit was an immersion in the Nachtigal project, considered as a reference in the sub-Saharan African energy sector both in industrial, environmental and social aspects. It was an opportunity for NHPC to share the expertise used to build the Nachtigal hydroelectric facility and its good practices in terms of supporting the Nachtigal project area's population and preserving the environment.

## About ACPI-RDC and the Grand Inga project

Created in 2015 by a presidential decree, the Grand Inga Project Development and Promotion Agency (ACPI-RDC) is the specialized service within the Presidency of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) to conduct the Grand Inga project.

Grand Inga is a series of hydroelectric dams in the lower Congo River. It has a 44,000 MW hydroelectric potential, of which 1,775 MW have already been installed at Inga 1 and Inga 2.

As part of the Inga 3 hydroelectric dam's construction, representatives of the ACPI-RDC visited the Nachtigal construction site and came away with a wealth of new ideas for their project.
