On the 24th of July 2024, NHPC's Managing Director officially handed over to the Minister of Employment and Vocational Training the keys of the workshops built and equipped by NHPC in Obala, Ntui and Mbandjock's (Rural Artisan/Home Economic Centers (RA/HECs).

The ceremony was held at Obala's RA/HEC and chaired by the Minister who personally inaugurated the automobile mechanics workshop built there, in the presence of the directors of the other RA/HECs beneficiaries and the administrative authorities of their respective districts.

This donation from NHPC, worth around 300 million franc CFA, aims to improve the learning conditions of the Nachtigal project area's students in fields such as automobile mechanics, wood and the clothing industry.

Vocational training, a lever of local economic **development** This significant investment from NHPC is part of the partnership agreement signed with the Ministry of Employment and Vocational Training on the 16th of September 2021 to promote employment and strengthen the vocational training system in the RA/HECs located in the Nachtigal project area by improving infrastructures and providing equipment and teaching materials.
