The International Monetary Fund visits the Nachtigal construction site

NHPC presents the Nachtigal project to the IMF

On a visit in Cameroon, a delegation from the International Monetary Fund (IMF) visited the Nachtigal hydroelectric facility construction site on the 5th of October 2024.

The visit included two highlights :

- A visit to NHPC's Public Information Centre, where the company (missions, shareholders, financing structure) and the Nachtigal project (industrial, environmental and social ambitions) were presented,
- A guided tour of the Nachtigal construction site led by Deputy Managing Director of NHPC, where they were able to witness the project's progress, completed at 97% at the end of September.

This visit was an opportunity for NHPC and the IMF to discuss the contribution of the Nachtigal project to Cameroon's energy sector.
