Nachtigal's labor camp handed over to the Ministry of Defence

NHPC, discussions facilitator between MINDEF, CCN and Elecnor

On the 18th of December 2024, the Minister of Defence signed protocols with the Directors of CCN and Elecnor, NHPC's co-contractors respectively in charge of the Nachtigal project's civil engineering and electromechanical works, for the handover of infrastructures and equipments of their base camps on the project site to the Ministry of Defence (MINDEF).

The signing of these protocols comes in a context of completion of works on the Nachtigal site, which is 98% complete, and the demobilization of both human and material resource.

The ceremony took place in the presence of the Deputy Managing Director of NHPC, in his role of chairman of the working group responsible of the examination of the above-mentioned bases retrocession modalities. The working group was made up of MINDEF, CCN, Elecnor, Energy and Water Resources Ministry, State Property, Surveys and Land Tenure Ministry teams and NHPC, as the project owner, which facilitated discussions between MINDEF, CCN and Elecnor.
