

Nachtigal's N°7 generating unit is now commissioned

420MW now available on the grid

Following its successful connection to the grid on the 27th of February 2025 and several weeks of tests, Nachtigal's unit no. 7 was officially commissioned on the 18th of March 2025.

This latest milestone marks the completion of the commissioning of all the facility units, which have now reached their full production capacity, with an installed capacity of 420MW.

The commissioning of this 7th and final unit symbolizes the end of the construction phase of the facility and its effective operation by NHPC for the next 35 years.

Competitive green energy

With its full production capacity of 420MW divided between 7 units of 60MW each, the Nachtigal hydroelectric facility provides clean, available and competitive energy, covering almost 30% of Cameroon's energy needs.

As well as helping to reduce carbon emissions and combat climate change, this major hydroelectric project improves people's quality of life, stimulates economic growth and plays an active role in the country's development, while generating substantial savings on fuel purchases and imports.
