Nominated by the Company's Board of Directors on the 20th of February 2025, Claire GALL is the new Managing Director of NHPC from the 1st of April 2025. Of French origin and seconded by EDF Group, she succeeds Vincent LEROUX, whose four-year term of office has come to an end.
