NHPC electrifies Ombandéné village

Electricity to improve people's living conditions

NHPC and its shareholder EDF Cameroun carried out a major solar electrification project in April 2025, worth almost CFAF 50 million, in Ombandéné village, in the Ntui district..

Overall :

- 303 individual 9W solar kits have been installed in households,
- 6 2.7 kW TV kits with 40-inch televisions have been deployed in the major neighbourhoods, and
- 4 large collective 5 to 6.2 kW solar systems have been installed to power community equipment such as fridges and mills.

This operation is part of NHPC's Local Economic Development Action Plan (PADEL), which aims to improve the living conditions of the communities around the Nachtigal project in a sustainable way, particularly in isolated areas not connected to the national electricity grid.

Entirely free of charge for the beneficiaries, this initiative has aroused great local enthusiasm and reflects NHPC's commitment to inclusive and sustainable local development.

A long-term commitment

This is not the first time NHPC has been involved in Ombandéné. Between 2022 and 2023, the company has already carried out a number of projects there, including the construction of two boreholes, the improvement of school infrastructure with an administrative building, and economic support to women with donations of chairs and tents for incomegenerating activities.
