77 students rewarded for their academic performances

As part of the third edition of its school excellence program, NHPC rewarded 77 students from schools of Batchenga, Ebebda, Obala, Mbandjock, Ntui and Sa'a on the 14th of November 2025.

The ceremony took place at the Nachtigal Camp in Batchenga in the presence of Claire Gall, NHPC's Managing Director, the representative the Lékié Divisional officer, administrative and traditional authorities from the Nachtigal project area, as well as school principals and parents of the winning students.

Among the 77 rewarded:

- 67 received a 150,000 CFA franc prize each
- 10 high school graduates received a 2,000,000 CFA franc university scholarship, including a laptop computer and coverage of their board and lodging, travel and catering expenses for three years.
