NHPC Reaffirms Its Commitment to Mpem & Djim National Park

First field mission of the Chief Executive Officer to the biodiversity offset site

From February 24 to 26, 2026, a delegation from Nachtigal Hydro Power Company (NHPC), led by its Chief Executive Officer Claire Gall, carried out a mission to Mpem and Djim National Park (PNMPD), the site selected as the biodiversity offset area for the impacts of the Nachtigal project.

Alongside the Park Conservation Service and experts from the Technical Assistance team, the delegation assessed activities financed by NHPC since 2018, amounting to CFAF 1.4 billion. These initiatives notably include ecological monitoring, anti-poaching operations, and the protection of natural habitats, implemented within the framework of the partnership with the Ministry of Forestry and Wildlife (MINFOF).

Investing in education for sustainable development

The mission also included several stops at schools located around the park, notably the Yangba Public School, the Linté Public School, and the Mendouh-Mindja Parents' School. These visits made it possible to assess the impact of NHPC's support, focused on providing educational materials and supporting the Nature Friends Clubs, in order to strengthen young people's awareness of biodiversity conservation.

On this occasion, the Chief Executive Officer recalled that beyond its contribution to the country's energy needs, the Nachtigal project carries a strong environmental and social ambition. In this context, education represents a key lever for raising awareness and supporting communities toward a sustainable approach to environmental conservation.
